 - [H2020 programme](#) : Tunisia is the only African and Arab country to obtain the status of associated country
- Challenge :
 - Clearly adopt a National Open Access policy

- National OA Repository [AOUT](#) : **Tunisian University Open Archive**
 - Framework : Invenio
 - Central Repository management
 - Scientific Content: Thesis and dissertations, research article (post/preprint), conference proceedings...

 - maintain and evolution e-Infrastructures
 - Work more closely with National REN : adapting new process/workflow and on Digital Transition
 - Proposal to integrate self archiving in the Doctoral Chart
