The Arab States Research and Education Network (ASREN) released the agenda for the e-AGE20, the 10th edition of the International Platform on Integrating Arab e-Infrastructure in a Global Environment, which will be held virtually during 15-16 December 2020, under the theme: “Power of e-Infrastructures - Shaping the Future of Online Research and Education”.

The two-day event features 30 renowned speakers and experts from across the global research and education community. The presenters will share their experiences and debate on the complex global phenomenon and scientific challenges that go beyond teaching online courses and sharing resources in today’s unprecedented isolation, with a focus on the role of e-Infrastructures in the crisis of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The e-AGE20 will comprise a high-level opening with a roundtable discussion on “Working Globally” featuring CEOs of Regional Research and Education Networks from around the world, and three other sessions with topics on Global Support, Regional and Global R&E Communities and Open Science and Open Access.

The conference will also feature one-day online workshops on LIBSENSE, ORCID and Routing Security as part of preconference activities.

Register Now for Routing Security Workshop

The Arab States Research and Education Network (ASREN) will be hosting a virtual Routing Security Workshop in coordination with Internet Society (ISOC) on December 17th, 2020.

The workshop will provide an introduction to routing security, the issues with global BGP routing system, and the [Mutually Assured Norms for Routing Security \(MANRS\)](#) initiative that aims to address these problems by encouraging operators to subscribe to four actions including filtering, anti-spoofing, coordination and address prefix validation.

It will also introduce participants to resources that can help improve awareness and knowledge



of routing security, including online tutorials and implementation guides. Finally, there will be a demonstration of the MANRS Observatory tool and some practical implementation exercises.

ASREN - LIBSESNE Workshop: Next Steps

The Arab States Research and Education Network (ASREN) will be hosting its third - LIBSENSE workshop entitled “Next steps”. This virtual workshop comes as a continuation and follow up on the LIBSENSE-III Workshop held in Tunisia in April 2019 and the ASREN - LIBSENSE Virtual Workshop held in October 2020. It will discuss supporting Open Knowledge through an initiative for harvesting data repositories in the Arab region with focus on Arabic content and language. More practices coming from the region on open access and open data repositories will be also presented.



The workshop will be held on 17th December 2020, in cooperation with WACREN, UbuntuNet Alliance, COAR and EIFL under the support of AfricaConnect3 and EUMEDCONNECT3 projects, and it will witness participations to highlight initiatives planned to act as Open Knowledge hubs at regional and global levels.

Repository managers, advocates and other open access and open science stakeholders (Libraries and library consortia, content and research data providers, National Research and Education Networks) are invited to participate to share experiences and exchange knowledge.
